How to use this Strategic Roadmap

The NCCA Strategic Roadmap is a key outcome of the NCCA Forum, held in Canberra on 21-24 June 2019. Forum participants and the Board have informed the development of a focused document to clearly **communicate the strategic focus** and **guide core work areas** for the NCCA over the next 3 years.

The one-page 'Strategic Roadmap' for NCCA has been designed to allow you to easily see an at-a-glance overview of how the diverse contributions from the Forum have been synthesised into a high-level strategic plan for the Council.

### A simple framework

Key issues and themes have been clustered into four 'sense-making' categories as **priority focus areas** for the organisation:

- A. COMMUNICATION & ENGAGEMENT
- **B. SUPPORT & PARTICIPATION**
- C. ECUMENICAL ADVOCACY
- D. COUNCIL DEVELOPMENT

These focus areas are aligned with the Council's Strategic Objectives:

Encouraging relationships Hebrews 10:24-25 Connection & fellowship

Matthew 18:20

Witnessing together
Acts 1:8

Enabling & resourcing 2 Corinthians 9:8

The focus areas are further defined by:

- Goals & outcomes: observable and measurable results to be sought by 2022
- Action program: proposed activities to deliver these results in short and medium-term timeframes.

The elements that have been mapped in this model are the foundations for the NCCA's strategic direction: a basis for moving forward as a collective Membership.

As a NCCA Member, you can use this Roadmap to:

- Identify opportunities to contribute or collaborate in new or renewed ways, as Churches as well as individuals
