- Be from a new and emerging community that is culturally and linguistically diverse.





What is a new and emerging community?

Post copy:

New and emerging communities are defined by the Federation of Ethnic Community Councils of Australia (FECCA) as:

"Migrants and refugees that have recently arrived in Australia and that may need additional support in the settlement process. The main identifiers of a new and emerging community (NEC) are a lack of established family networks, support systems, community structures and resources, unfamiliarity with mainstream services, and challenges in accessing these services[1]. NECs may have other identifiers including limited English language proficiency, high numbers of refugees, low levels of formal education, financial vulnerabilities, difficulty in finding long-term and sustainable employment.

The AMF encourages scholarship applications from young women who belong to new and emerging communities in Australia.



To be eligible for the Scholarship, you must meet the following criteria:

- be a woman (including female identifying persons) aged between 18 - 29 years old
- be an Australian citizen or permanent resident
- be from a new and emerging community that is culturally and linguistically diverse.

You should also demonstrate how you embody or aspire to embody the values of passion, commitment. respect, leadership and innovation and how your chosen venture, project or activity promotes a prosperous multicultural Australia.

The selection process


