The Rev Dr Ray Williamson OAM Dr Williamson is an Anglican Priest with Parish ministry in Newcastle, Sydney and Canberra.

He was on the teaching staff of St John's Theological College Morpeth, St Andrew's Greek Orthodox Theological College and St Patrick's Seminary. He was the co-founder and Director of the Centre for Ecumenical Studies.

For 21 years he served as the General Secretary of the NSW Ecumenical Council and President from 2018-2021.

Author of books: "An Introduction to Hegel's Philosophy of Religion", 1984; "Stages on the Way I", 1994; and "Stages on the Way II", 2007; "Pilgrims of Hope: An Ecumenical Journey 1980-2010".

He was awarded an Order of Australia Medal in 2008 for his ecumenical work.
